Spirit portraiture is a form of evidential mediumship expressed through art. Unlike traditional portrait drawing, where accuracy is the primary focus, spirit art seeks to represent the communicator's individuality and energy.

The drawing may not always resemble a conventional photograph, but it will hold key features, emotions, and expressions that will be recognisable to those who receive it.

Spirit Portraiture is the art of allowing Spirit communicators to impress their presence onto paper. It is part mediumship, part drawing practice, and part surrender.

It is not about creating a photographic likeness. Instead, it is about reaching for essence, memory, and familiarity with just enough to make recognition possible. Think of yourself as both an artist and a bridge. Both skill and Spirit guide your pencil. You are sketching a likeness that resembles their features.
